Dear Trinity Parents:

I am so excited to let you know that for the 2026/2027 school year we will continue to offer need-based financial aid. As the funds are limited, there will be several requirements for applications made for the 2026/2027 Academic Year. Although any family may apply, priority will be given to families that meet the following guidelines:

- Have at least one child currently enrolled at Trinity Episcopal School for the **2025/2026** Academic Year (current families),
- Will have one or more children attending Trinity for the **2026/2027** Academic Year and,
- Are in good financial standing with Trinity Episcopal School

Or

- A **current parishioner** in good standing at Trinity Episcopal Church

The application process will be similar to that of most of the other local private schools. Families will submit an online application to a Grant and Aid entity that will analyze the financial need of the applicants and submit a report of need back to Trinity, where a financial aid committee will make the final awards based on the reports sent to us. Trinity will be working with the online agency FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment for the application process. FACTS is one of the largest financial-aid management agencies and is used by many of our sister schools in the Southwest Association of Episcopal Schools and the National Association of Episcopal Schools. Additionally, they are used locally by Southwest Christian School.

Financial aid applicants will still be required to pay the annual registration (\$200) and supply fees (\$250). Financial Aid Grants will only be applied to tuition for the 2026/2027 academic year and will only be awarded to accounts that are kept current. Financial aid awards will not exceed 50% of a student's academic year tuition and cannot be applied to before care, Stay & Play, enrichment classes, Mother's Day Out, or other programs. Families entering PreK 4 or Bridge needing financial aid to make a decision between remaining at TES or moving to Universal PreK with FWISD will have two business days after receiving their award letter to accept the scholarship grant or withdraw without financial penalty.

There will be a short application period from January 1st to March 1, 2026 with award decisions being made shortly thereafter. Please be aware of this application deadline which requires that your family's 2025 taxes be completed before you can submit an application. Families that are interested in learning more about the application process should contact the school office.
