We have been working hard to get re-enrollment for the 2026/2027 school year ready for you. Please read ahead for more details!

Re-Enrollment for 2026/2027

The Re-enrollment process begins with Parent/Teacher Conferences on February 5th and 6th. Conference time sign-ups have already begun, but here is the link if you have not already picked a time to meet with your child's teacher: <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/4090F4DACA928A1F94-fall#/>.

Re-enrollment for current families will begin the following Monday, February 9th and will be done via the ChildPilot portal. This is super easy and can be done either from the ChildPilot App or the ChildPilot Website. Reenrollment will go live at **10am on Monday, February 9th**. At that time, you will be able to log in and enroll your child(ren). Pre-Registration can be located in the menu. Once you have selected your child and days of the week you want them to attend, you will be prompted to pay the non-refundable \$450 enrollment fee. If you prefer to pay that by check, you will need to come by the office to complete your enrollment. I am attaching the 26/27 Tuition and Program information and will have it available at conferences as well.

Parents of incoming siblings... you must have them entered in ChildPilot before you can enroll them. It is very easy, just log on and edit your family to add the younger child. If you need assistance, please call or email the office for assistance.

Financial Aid

The Financial Aid application is live for anyone wishing to apply for Financial Aid for the 2026/2027 school year. I have emailed the information out, and it is available on our website. The application deadline is March 1st. Please be aware you **MUST** have completed your family's 2025 income taxes before you can apply for financial aid. Please reach out if you need assistance.

Summer Fun '26

Summer Fun registration for current families will go live on **Monday, February 23th at 10am**. It will be in ChildPilot under Reservations, much like MDO. In the meantime, be looking out for all of the Summer Fun information soon so that you can begin making your summer vacation plans! There are a variety of summer programs available to your children. I have included descriptions below, but please ask if you need additional information. Summer Fun '26 Enrollment will be in a three stage process this year. Current Families (Feb 23rd), incoming families enrolled for 26/27 (Feb 27), and Open enrollment for non-TES families (March 2). **All registrations must be pre-paid and are NON-REFUNDABLE. NEW THIS YEAR: **We are unable to accommodate switching camp weeks once you have registered. Because we schedule our wonderful staff based specifically on enrollment numbers to ensure safe ratios, we ask that you please check your summer calendar carefully before signing up.****

Summer Fun '26 Options:

- Summer Fun is a great summer camp activity for children **18 months old through three-year-olds** (Must be 18+ months to attend Summer Fun. Summer Fun enrollment is based on enrollment age for fall 2026). It

is a non-academic camp focusing on social/emotional learning and independence skills. Children arrive in swimsuits and begin the day in the classroom with fun activities and then move outdoors to play on the playground in the water sprinklers, sand/water tables, as well as other fun outdoor activities. Pick your day option – (2 day (TTh) or 3 day (MWF) and then the desired week(s). You may also enroll in both a 2 day and a 3 day camp for the same week as space is available. Summer Fun is from 9am to noon and is open to friends and family of TES students, so bring your friends with you! **New and non-TES students must have registration paperwork and immunizations on file**

- PreK Power-Up is a camp designed with our incoming PreK 4 friends in mind! Children entering PreK4 for the 2026/2027 school year are encouraged to attend this academic camp that is filled with so much fun. Campers spend the 5 day week reviewing material and getting ready for a brand-new school year (and a new building) while having a great time with friends. Pick your week(s) but all sessions are M-F from 9am to noon. Friends are welcome if they are 4 years old by September 1st and entering a PreK 4 program. Must be Potty Trained. **New and non-TES students must have registration paperwork and immunizations on file**
- Trinity Academy (Kindergarten Camp) is open to any student that has completed a PreK 4 or Bridge year and will be attending a Bridge class or Kindergarten in the fall. This fun academic based camp is designed to help students retain their academic skills in a fun and creative way. Choose your week(s) but all camps are Monday-Friday from 9-noon. Friends and family of TES students are welcome, so bring your friends with you! **New and non-TES students must have registration paperwork and immunizations on file**
- Summer Early Care will be offered from 8-9am daily (Yoga on Friday) and Summer Enrichments will be offered M-Th from 12-2pm. TES will close at Noon on Fridays. Class offerings and sign-ups will be available in late April or early May.

26/27 Open Enrollment for New Families

For those with friends interested in enrollment for the 2026/2027 school year, thank you for helping us spread the word. Our Spring Open House will be on Tuesday, February 17th from 5:30-7pm and Open Enrollment for new families will begin on Friday, February 20th. Open enrollment will be in ChildPilot, in a similar process to that of current students. Open Enrollment for Summer Fun for new families will begin, Friday, Feb 27th and for non-TES families on Monday, March 2nd. We have also been in contact with several Alumni families and parishioners of Trinity Episcopal Church. They have a special day for enrollment but need to contact the school office for their enrollment info after their eligibility has been verified. If you have talked with an Alumni parent interested in returning to TES for a sibling, please have them contact us.

I know this is a lot of information, but I wanted to get it to you as soon as possible. I know we just began a new calendar year, but many of you are planning for summer vacations and for the fun of the next school year.
